### #1 THE BIBLE

#### 1. KEY VERSE

> 2 Timothy 3:16-17

#### 2. <u>DID THE BIBLICAL TEXT CHANGE OVER TIME AND TRANSCRIPTION?</u>

- > No
- Dead Sea scrolls found in 1946. Date between 150BC 70AD...
- Shows that the text has not changed

#### 3. How do we know the Bible is from God and not just men?

> 2 Peter 1:20-21 – prophecy (the Bible) came by Holy Spirit

#### 4. How do we know that the New Testament is inspired?

- > 2 Peter 3:15 Paul & rest of scripture
- 1 Timothy 5:18 Quotes both Deuteronomy 25:4 (OT) & Luke 10:7 (NT)
  calling them both scripture.

#### 5. WHAT IS THE JOT AND TITTLE (MATT. 5:18?)

- ➤ Jot = smallest Hebrew letter in size
- > Tittle = smallest part of letter
  - Which means that even the smallest detail of scripture will be fulfilled

#### 6. What are the New Translations based on?

- > The (A) Alpha
- > The (B) Vadiscus
- Egyptian manuscripts / 3,000 difference in Gospel / These equal only 1% of all biblical manuscripts.

#### 7. Does John 7:53-8:11 belong in the Bible?

- > Yes.
- ➤ In Majority manuscripts 900 have story whereas 100 don't. / Majority accounts of 90-95% of all biblical text

### #2 THE GODHEAD (TRINITY)

#### 1. KEY VERSE

➤ Matthew 28:19

#### 2. YOU GIVE THE DEFINITION OF THE TRINITY?

- "There is only one God, but in the unity of the Godhead there are three eternal and coequal Persons, the same in \*essence but distinct in \*subsistence."
  - \*Essence = The core of who God is
  - \*Subsistence = the function within the trinity

### 3. <u>Can you prove that God, Jesus, and The Holy Spirit are Equal?</u>

➤ Matthew 28:19 - speaks about baptizing people in the **name** which means they are equal

### 4. If the Bible says that God is one, then how can He be in Three Persons?

- ➤ The Hebrew word used is Deut. 6:4 is *Echad* which means "oneness in unity."
- This is the same word used in Genesis 2:24 two becoming one flesh

### 5. How can you prove that Jesus and the Holy Spirit are both God?

- Jesus John 10:30 People say Jesus is God / also John 1
- ➤ Holy Spirit -Acts 5:3-4 The Holy Spirit is called God

### #3 GOD THE FATHER

#### 1. Key verse(s)

Understand: Romans 1:18-24

#### 2. What Are The Two Categories Of God's Attributes?

#### Incommunicable

• These are attributes that only God has and cannot be shared.

#### Communicable

o These are attributes that God shares with us.

## #4 GOD THE SON (JESUS)

#### 1. KEY VERSE

➤ Galatians 4:4-5

#### 2. IS JESUS GOD?

- > Yes
- ➤ Isaiah 9:6 calls Virgin's son Mighty God
- Luke 1:35 Jesus is called Son of God

#### 3. Does anyone in Scripture call Jesus God?

- > Yes
- > 1. Thomas (John 20:28) My Lord and God
- ➤ 2. Paul (Titus 2:13) Waiting for our God & Savior Jesus

### 4. Since Jesus is the Firstborn of Creation does that mean He was created?

- ➤ No it means preeminence.
- ➤ John 1:3 He made everything so He could not create Himself

### 5. What is the difference between the terms "Son of Man" and "Son of God?"

- Son of man focuses on Jesus humanity
- ➤ Son of God focuses on His deity

#### 6. IS JESUS LESS THEN GOD?

- No, He is God
- > -John 5:17-18 claims to be equal with God
- > -Jesus' 7 "I AM" statements referred back to God saying I AM In Exodus 6

#### 7. IS JESUS STILL A MAN?

- > Yes
- > I Timothy 2:5 The man Jesus Christ

## #5 GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT

#### 1. Definition

- ➤ The Holy Spirit is a member of the trinity ... and is a **person** who **convicts** the world of sin righteousness and of judgment
- > ... He is the Supernatural Agent in **regeneration**, **baptizing** all believers into the **body** of Christ, **indwelling** and **sealing** them unto the day of redemption.

#### 2. WHAT DOES "FILLING" MEAN?

➤ Being controlled by the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 5:18)

#### 3. Can a believer be filled only once or many times?

- Many times
- > Ephesians 5:18 keep being filled

#### 4. What does it mean to be led by the Spirit?

> To have victory over sin

#### 5. What is bearing fruit?

- ➤ 1. Leading others to Christ
- > 2. Showing the fruits of the Spirit
- ➤ -Galatians 5:22-23

#### 6. Do you have to speak in tongues once you have the Spirit?

- > No
- > 1 Corinthians 12:28-31 all can't speak in tongues

#### 7. WHAT IS WATER BAPTISM / WHAT IS SPIRITUAL BAPTISM?

- Water Baptism
  - o Is outwardly Identifying with body of Christ (Church)
- > Spiritual Baptism
  - o is what happens inwardly the moment you are saved 1 Corinthians 12:12-13

#### 8. CAN YOU LOSE THE HOLY SPIRIT?

- > No
- > Ephesians 1:13-14 you are sealed from salvation till Rapture

### **#6 SALVATION**

#### 1. **Definition**

Salvation is a <u>free</u> and <u>unearned</u> gift which God desires to impart to all men but it is only received by a personal <u>faith</u> in the Lord Jesus Christ.

3	Civil Government	Starts with Noah's Flood - Ends with Babel
4	Promise	Starts with the Call of Abraham – Ends with Giving of the Law
5	Mosaic Law	Starts with Giving of Law- Ends with Death of Jesus the Christ
6	Grace	Starts with the creation of the Church- Ends at Armageddon
7	Divine Government	Starts with Millennial Kingdom - Ends with Final Judgment

### #8 TOTAL DEPRAVITY | 3 FORMS OF SIN

1. <u>TOTAL DEPRAVITY</u> = IS THE THEOLOGICAL CONCEPT THAT MANKIND CANNOT BE SAVED BY HIS OWN MERIT (YOU CANNOT EARN YOUR WAY INTO HEAVEN.)

#### 2. What are the 3 forms of Sin?

- > The lust of the flesh
- ➤ The lust of the eyes
- > The pride of life
  - o 1 John 2:15-16

#### 3. What verse explains how we are tempted to sin?

➤ <u>James 1:14-15</u> - But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed

#### 4. How can we overcome sin?

Walk in the Spirit - Galatians 5:16

# #9-10 ETERNAL SECURITY / ASSURANCE OF BELIEVERS

#### 1. What Is The Difference Between Eternal Security And Assurance?

- Eternal security is what God does
- > Assurance is understanding that truth

#### 2. Can you lose your salvation?

- > No
  - o Ephesians 1:13-14 we are sealed
  - o John 10:27-30 Jesus is holding on to us

#### 3. How long are we sealed for?

- Until the day of redemption Ephesians 4:30
- ➤ Romans 8:23 day of redemption = rapture

#### 4. HAVE THOSE WHO HAVE LEFT THE FAITH LOST THEIR SALVATION?

➤ No - their works show their lack of faith -1 John 2:18-20 Those who left the faith were never truly saved
