


#2 - Passage

- ▶ His main point is that Jesus is the Messiah who the Jews had killed just 40 days before...





Reveal







Change your mind from rejecting Jesus to believing He is Lord.


The Holy Spirit enters & seals you at the time of Salvation. Be publicly baptized to tell the world of your Salvation.









Communism Vs. Christianity






- Individuals are forced by authorities to give.

"The first requisite for the happiness of the people is the abolition of religion." "But the righteous are glad; they rejoice before God and celebrate with joy." (Psalm 68:3)






"I wish to avenge myself against the One who rules above."

Justice executed is a joy to the righteous, but a terror to those who practice iniquity.


