What is the definition of the Godhead (Trinity?)			There is only one living and true God. Yet, the one God is three distinct Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. These three have distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being. They enjoy eternal communion and are coeternal and coequal.	Level 1
"What verse describes the Father, Son, and Spirit as one?	Matthew 28:19	"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."	The "Name" is singular, yet it points to the Father, Son, & Spirit - 3 in 1.	
How do we know there is only One God and not many gods?	Isaiah 44:6	"This is what the Lord, the King of Israel and its Redeemer, the Lord of Armies, says: I am the first and I am the last. There is no God but me."	God Himself said there is only one God.	Level 2
lls there any hints of the Godhead in the Old Testament?	Genesis 1:26a	Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness.	God uses the term "our" and not "mine." In the next verse God makes mankind in "His image." This implies the reality of Godhead.	
How do we know that the Holy Spirit is God?	Acts 5:3-4	³ "Ananias," Peter asked, "why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the proceeds of the land? ⁴ Wasn't it yours while you possessed it? And after it was sold, wasn't it at your disposal? Why is it that you planned this thing in your heart? You have not lied to people but to God."	Lying to the Holy Spirit is lying to God because the Holy Spirit is God.	
Name two verses that say Jesus is God?	John 1:1	In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.	Jesus the Word of God is called God	Level 3
	Romans 9:5	The ancestors are theirs, and from them, by physical descent, came the Christ, who is God over all, praised forever. Amen.	The Christ - Jesus is called the God over all.
