ls God the Father a spirit or a force?	John 4:24	God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in Spirit and in truth."	He is not a lifeless force - He is a spirit.	Level 1
Are there many gods or only One God?	lsaiah 44:6	This is what the Lord, the King of Israel and its Redeemer, the Lord of Armies, says: I am the first and I am the last. There is no God but me.	God the Father makes it clear that there are no other gods. This must be understood in the context of the trinity.	
What chapter explains that God knows all things, is all powerful, and is everywhere at once?	Psalm 139		Psalm 139 explains the absolute sovereignty of God.	
How much authority does God the Father have?	Psalm 24:1	"The earth and everything in it, the world and its inhabitants, belong to the Lord"	He has authority over all things because all things belong to Him.	
What does it mean in Genesis 1:26 that God made man in His imagine?	Genesis 1:26a	Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, according to our likeness.	God made man in: His moral image (the ability to know right from wrong) His mental image (the ability to think and choose) His spiritual image (to have a spirit indwelling each of us) *notice the term "our" - this refers to the trinity	Level 2
How did God show His love for fallen world?	John 3:16	For God loved the world in this way: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.	God is the one who created the plan of salvation and sent His only Son to earth.	
What is God's relationship with those who place their faith in Jesus Christ?	Galatians 3:26	for through faith, you are all sons of God in Christ Jesus.	Christians become children of God and have the right to call Him Father.	
Do people who don't seek after God have an excuse because they are not saved?	Romans 1:18-20	For God's wrath is revealed from heaven against all godlessness and unrighteousness of people who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth, since what can be known about God is evident among them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, that is, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen since the creation of the world, being understood through what he has made. As a result, people are without excuse.	God's word is clear. He has revealed Himself to all of mankind and no one will have a legitimate excuse on the day of judgment.	Level 3
